



Travelling to City of Bath College

Travelling by road

If travelling to the College by motorway, leave the M4 at junction 18 and take the A46 and A4 to Bath.

Parking

There are no parking facilities for students at the College. Avon Street multi-storey car park is nearby and Charlotte Street long stay car park is a five minute walk away. On-street parking is available in 'pay and display' areas. The machines will tell you the cost and length of stay in these spaces. Parking on the outskirts of the city is free.

The City of Bath is also served by three Park and Ride's, Odd Down, Newbridge and Lansdown. They all stop within a 3 minute walk of the College. Buses run every 10-15 minutes from 06.15 - 20.30.

Travelling to the College by train

Bath Spa station is a 5 minute walk from the College, (leaving the station turn left along Dorchester Street and turn right into St James' Parade, the College is on the left hand side). First Great Western runs an extensive timetable in and out of Bath Spa servicing the local area as well as London, Wales and the North. Trains to London run every 30 minutes. Construction Skills Centre at Bath Trade Park

From Lower Bristol Road (A36) turn in to Westmoreland Road by the Green Park Tavern. After going under the railway bridge turn right into Westmoreland Station Road. The construction Skills Centre is at the end of the road on the left hand side.
